“Bike share will play an essential role in growing Milwaukee as we work to achieve my vision of One Million Milwaukeeans”

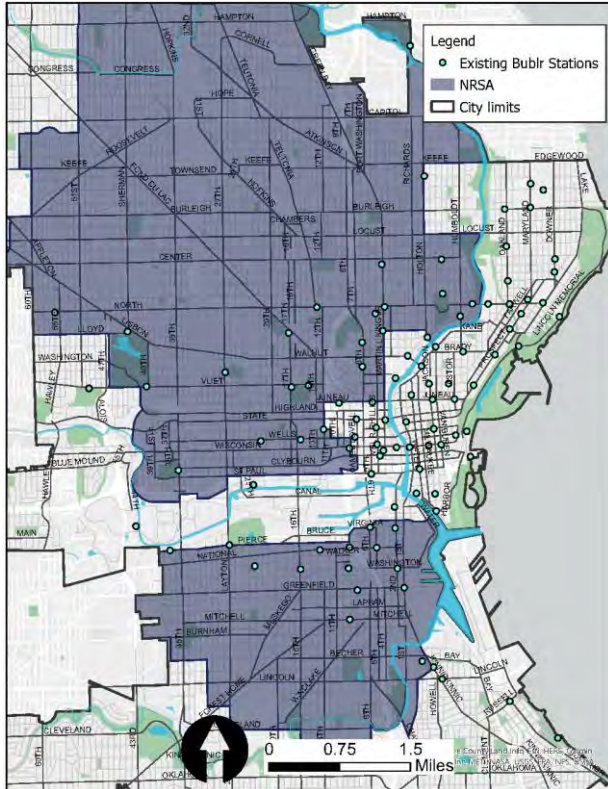

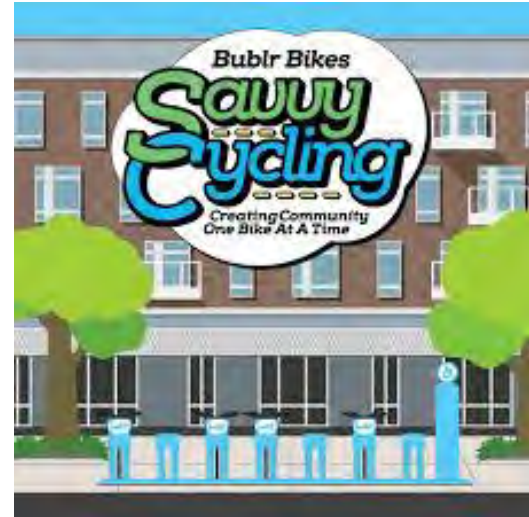
