

Community Outreach Intern Opportunity (Waukesha County Unit 20)

University of Wisconsin Madison Extension at Waukesha County is seeking an upper class undergraduate or graduate student Intern to join our team working in several neighborhoods in the City of Waukesha. Responsibilities will include developing new relationships with neighborhood groups, coordinating educational housing improvement workshops, assisting with programs at assisting with education programs at a community garden including coordinating a summer teen program, analyzing neighborhood housing data, writing reports, assisting with the development of marketing messaging, and recruiting educational program participants.

University of Wisconsin Madison Extension programs apply the research and resources from the University System to build strong families, develop youth and adult leaders, improve nutrition and health, promote family and public safety, strengthen neighborhoods, and provide opportunities for developing life skills and workforce development.
