



# WAPA Endowment Scholarship

Each year, the Wisconsin chapter of the American Planning Association sponsors two full-tuition scholarships for students entering the planning profession. These students, one at each of the state's accredited graduate programs, the University of Wisconsin-Madison and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, are selected based on merit, planning experience and financial need. The APA - WI is proud to have this opportunity to sponsor the next generation of planning professionals.

## *Eligibility*

Eligible students must be entering one of the state's accredited master's of urban planning programs, must be Wisconsin residents, and must have graduated from a Wisconsin public high school. All scholarships will be awarded for four semesters beginning in the fall semester.

## *Selection*

An awards committee at each school will select the recipient based upon:

- Financial Need
- Academic merit
- Leadership skills
- Community service
- Planning work experience
- Interest in planning for sustainable and socially just cities and regions
