Board members are encouraged to attend in person however, if something comes up, teleconferencing is available. The January board meeting is a day-long planning session and the last few years, has been held in Milwaukee.

This year, the following positions are up for election:

President- Elect – 2 yr. position followed by 2 yrs. as President and 2 yrs. as Immediate Past-President

VP Membership – 3 yr. position

NE District Representative – 3 year position, must reside in the district

SW District Representative – 3 year position, must reside in the district
